WALK THE WALK



Trumpeter Eric Siereveld has returned to New York City after living/ teaching in Madison, WI for three years. Eric's trio, quartet and his newest musical endeavor, the Organic Quintet, can be heard all over NYC and the tri-state area. He is frequently seen performing as a sideman with small groups and big bands.

and performs with on- and off-Broadway productions.

Walk the Walk is Eric Siereveld and the Organic Quintet's debut album. The group features some of the finest musicians from NYC and the Midwest. Tony Barba is a Madison-based tenor player and regular member of the Young Blood Brass Band. On B3 organ, Steve Snyder is the head of jazz studies at DePauw University in Greencastle, IN. Drummer Mitch Shiner is



one of Milwaukee's most exciting young musicians. And from NYC, the great Jonathan Kreisberg is the group's guitarist. Aside from leading his trio and quartet, it's Kreisberg's association with legendary organist Dr. Lonnie Smith for which he is most well known by jazz audiences.

The music on *Walk the Walk* is a fresh perspective on the organ jazz tradition. *The Last Innovator*, written by Siereveld, features an angular melody, and harmony inspired by Joe Henderson's *Recorda Me*. *Toughin' Up* is a muscular blues reflecting the leader's time spent in Brooklyn. The album's title track is a sturdy, soulful tune characterizing



the band's musical approach. Siereveld's warm flugelhorn and Kreisberg's lush tone gives a tender performance of Rodgers and Hart's *Bewitched, Bothered & Bewildered*. From Danish bassist Morten Haxholm and Jonathan Kreisberg, *Occam's Razor* is a fast, sharp minor blues. *B-Town Bop* is a tribute to the late great jazz educator David Baker. *Other Side (of the Hudson)* reflects the mood

of NJ's small east coast towns. Closing out the album, *Split-Finger* is a boogaloo in the spirit of Lee Morgan and Blue Mitchell's great Blue Note boogaloos and adds the conga playing of Aaron Gochberg. The pulsing, groovy undercurrent brings the album to a funky conclusion.

While *Walk the Walk* pays tribute to the great organ jazz records of the 1950s and 60s, it's a step in entirely new directions. Eric Siereveld's Organic Quintet featuring Jonathan Kreisberg's debut album proves that organ jazz can still be unpredictable, soulful and swinging.
